for the recording and publication of

photo material

by the BASE

- Declaration of consent for participants of the research symposium SafeND -

The Federal Office for the Safety of Nuclear Waste Disposal (BASE) intends to take photos and film footage or have them taken during the hybrid events of the SafeND research symposium as part of its public relations work. The consent refers to photo material in which a participant is recognizably depicted, either alone or together with other persons. The photo material shall be taken and published for the purpose of reporting and documenting BASE activities as part of its official public relations work, which is without spatial restrictions. The publication of the photo material as part of BASE's public relations work relates to the following channels:

- printed materials produced by BASE for PR purposes
- the BASE intranet (not publicly accessible)
- the websites of the BASE
- publicly accessible social networks (Twitter, Instagram)

As a matter of principle, the photographic material shall be published stating the first and last name of the participant(s) depicted. This does not apply to publications on publicly accessible BASE social media channels. There shall definitely not be any publication of photo material with names on those channels.

The legal basis for the processing of the (special) personal data shall be your declaration of consent in accordance with Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a), 7 DSGVO.

I have read the **information** below:

- I have noted that information on the Internet is accessible worldwide, can be found with search engines and linked with other information, from which profiles (for example, personality, movement profiles, etc.) about me can be created under certain circumstances. I am aware that information placed on the Internet, including photos, can easily be copied, and redistributed and that there are specialized archiving services whose goal is to permanently document the state of certain internet pages. This can lead to information published on the internet being available elsewhere and processed by third parties even after it has been deleted from the original site.

- Insofar as I consent to publication in so-called **social networks** (social media), I have taken note that social networks may disseminate content without BASE having any influence on the number or type of dissemination actions by users. By commenting and subsequently sharing the original posting, there is a theoretical possibility that individuals depicted are or will be exposed to unfavorable or negative comments. When posting on certain social media platforms (e.g. Facebook), complete deletion of the photos may not be possible.

- Insofar as the photographic material may reveal indications of **special categories of personal data** such as my racial or ethnic origin, political opinion, religious or ideological beliefs, trade union membership, health or sexual orientation (e.g. skin color, headgear, pins, glasses) or the processed photo material contains biometric data for the unambiguous identification of a natural person, my consent for the above-mentioned purposes also expressly refers to this information.

- I am aware that this declaration of consent is voluntary and that I may revoke it by written declaration to BASE at any time with future effect. The revocation can be made in written form to "Bundesamt für die Sicherheit der nuklearen Entsorgung, Behördlicher Datenschutzbeauftragter, z.Hd, Robin Heilmann, Wegelystraße 8, 10623 Berlin" or by email to the email address datenschutzbeauftragter@bfe.bund.de. The effective revocation means that published photo material of the person shall be removed from the BASE website and no further photo material of the person shall be posted. As regards the deletion of photo material on the internet, including social networks, please refer to the abovementioned information. In the case of printed products, the effective revocation means that photo material of the person will no longer be published in new editions of the products already printed. A revocation does not affect the lawfulness of the processing carried out based on the consent prior to the revocation.
